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
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FOREWORD 3

"People will come and go, children will come and grow, Shri Sathya Sai Balvikas will always shine like the Sun to make Balvikas children glow everywhere forever."










Rajni Suri Himachal Pradesh





strength to fight my circumstances. This was the time when I could feel the divinity of Bhagawan all around me. After that day things changed as if I was never evertense or depressed.




As a school child, I overcame the stage fear and in return I won the appreciation of all my teachers. I realized that Sri Sathya Sai Balvikas had slowly transformed me.







From color televisions to satellite cable TV, from personal computers to internet proliferation, from pagers to smartphones; our world has seen waves of paradigm shifts which virtually dismantled every shackle people were once bound by. However, what has also been observed of society at large during this time makes for a sorry commentary quite contrary to what economic development should have helped achieve. While on the one hand, the whole world has become one large family, erstwhile joint families have begun disintegrating into nuclear ones, divorce rates and teenage pregnancies have seen a spike, jealousy and discontentment has become commonplace, and despite living in a hyperconnected world, youngsters often find themselves disconnected and lonely.

It's probably this very foresight that the Lord envisioned and initiated the Sri Sathya Sai Balvikas program (originally named Balvihar) in the same year when man first set foot on the moon - 1969. At a time when most commercial organisations globally, have been unable to sustainably thrive over long periods of time, the Sri Sathya Sai Balvikas - a completely non-

commercial, voluntary program has completed fifty golden years with lakhs of students world-over having passed out as beneficiaries. This noble movement started by the Avatar of this age, Himself, has today grown into a social revolution of sorts. Not only does it transform the lives of these children but also creates a lasting positive impact on their families and the societies that they live in. While most educational institutions dole out certificates of degrees in literacy, they do precious little to eradicate moral poverty. Which is why Baba would often say, "Education is for life and not merely for a living".

The fact that the Sri Sathya Sai Balvikas program continues to grow in strength even after five decades is testimony to its foundation which is based on Baba's exhortation that "The End of Education is Character".



We came across to her to be very emotionally balanced as individuals and our positive outlook towards life amazed her. Towards the end of our stay in Bangalore, she was so drawn to our way of life that she herself got both her sons enrolled into our Balvikas class and wanted them to benefit from it the way she perceived we did too. For us, this was a very satisfying experience as it gave us the belief that we are living up to our master's dictum, "Your life is my message".

THE MIRACLE AND BLESSING OF BEING A SRI SATHYA SAI BAL VIKAS STUDENT



Responsibility was bestowed upon me to escort the students of Swami from Chandigarh to Shimla in these eight and half hours. For an individual of flesh and blood; the task was mammoth, gigantic and herculean – name it with any adjective as you may like. During the rush

and shuttle of transits, I constantly realised that Swami Himself was getting everything done as I was one of His beloved Sri Sathya Sai Bal Vikas students. That was one of numerous instances to quote as His Divine Miracle for a Bal Vikas student. I felt proud of my grooming as a Bal Vikas student.

My life is continuing and I shall remain always His Bal Vikas Student to be some day merged at His Divine Lotus Feet in eternal bliss.

THREE LOTUSES IN THE POOL...AND. MILLIONS EVERYWHERE



Like, every old city, this city has also its problems. The place where I live is such an area where the common man is forced by the society put into daily grinds so much so that no energy is left for education, and moral upliftment is a distant goal for parents. I always noticed from childhood that many people in our society had disturbed lives.

Lucky are those, who are born and grow in the fold of God. I was yet to realise it. I belong to a business family where my mother firmly believes in God and on the other hand my father who believes in nothing other than 'Work is God'. We are four siblings. My elder sister, after graduation, got married in a blessed family and is now a homemaker. I and my brother are twins and there is also one younger brother. During our childhood, when we might have been four or five years old, respected elder brother Bhabasis Das(Lulu Bhai) came to live in a house just next to our home. Daily at exactly 5:30pm, Bhajan was conducted at his place. We, all kids used to go there because at the end of the Bhajan session prasad would be distributed. Then slowly we started attending Balvikas every Sunday. Gradually we became so much attached to Balvikas that we could not live a Sunday without it. In the evening, when other children used to play, we used to attend Bhajans daily without fail. At that time, in our locality, hardly there would be any child whoever succeeded in studies. Maximum

numbers of children were under matriculates. My grandparents and their ancestors also did never complete matriculation. But, with Swami's Grace and blessings of our parents, we all four did well in our studies. My twin brother became a Doctor in Indian Army. I became an Engineer and my younger brother became a Chartered Accountant. It was all possible only as a result of the blessings of Bhagawan.

Sri Sathya Sai Balvikas not only changed our childhood experiences but also became an integral part of our lives by infusing greater human values of excellence in a silent and sublime manner. The grace of Swami through Balvikas made us believe that we could be the lotuses despite the slur and silt in a pool. A BIG THANK YOU to SWAMI to be a part of our life and make us to be a part of the Sai Family.

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


Lavanya Punjab




Pratik Nikhade Rajasthan

Chanting slokas and Vedam at high pitch (almost shouting with ecstasy) in a group was real fun and gave me a lot of joy. Unknowingly, it drove away my shyness. In my class 6th, I chanted 'Ganananthwa' at my school competition and won 1st prize without any preparation. Needless to say that I needed no preparation as we were chanting it quite often. Winning this prize was a turning point in my life. I gained so much confidence that I started participating in competitions like essay writing, elocution, pick and speak and never went back home without a prize.

Silent sitting and Jyothi meditation were taught to us by one of my Gurus and this helped me a lot during my exams especially the one with Maths. Whenever I was tensed, I used to sit in front of the altar and do Jyothi meditation and this used to relieve me of the exam anxiety. Unknowingly, this process helped me to stay calm and balanced. When I was in 5th class our family was in Puttaparthi for Dassera celebrations. As per the advice of my father I sat to meditate in Poornachandra auditorium after Swami left the stage and the Yagna was going on. I realized that there was no Jyothi to do so and prayed to Swami for his photograph so that I could look at Swami's picture and close my eyes to meditate. As I prayed so and opened my eyes, to my utter dismay, I saw a Swamy's photograph on my lap which read "I will protect you as the eyelids protect the eyes". This incident left a lasting impression on me and I was assured by Swami that He is always with me.

Bal Vikas Gurus introduce children to Seva and my Guru Smt. Susheela garu insisted us to serve in water camps during summer vacation. Pouring water in glasses, serving buttermilk, taking chances to fill the buckets was thoroughly enjoyed and during such time I developed a lot of interest in Seva as it gave me a lot of satisfaction. As I grew, my desire to serve also grew.

Few of my seniors joined Swami's Institute and with Swami's grace I joined the Sri Sathya Sai Institute of Higher Learning, Anantapur campus and did my B.Sc and M.Sc in Food Science and Nutrition. I had the rarest of the rare priveleges of receiving the Gold medal for Master's Program from the Divine hands. After passing out from the Institute, I actively participated in Samithi activities. In 2008 I was

nominated as District Youth Coordinator for Mahilas for Ranga Reddy district and subsequently as State Youth Coordinator for Andhra Pradesh and Telangana in 2016 and now hold the post for the Telangana state.


The seeds of virtue and values had been sown in my heart which helped me to grow into a tree that helps those in distress to rest under its shade.
