
Time To Assess Spiritual Progress...


Amend...Revise...Surmise...Summarise...Overhaul...Install

The divine qualities to emulate from Beloved Bhagawan are endless. It can overwhelm the scope within us all for our overall transformation and progress.


If only we awaken and desire our evolution...will it speed our journey towards the light of our own divinity.
