We have been blessed with an opportunity by Bhagawan to be a part of HIS 93rd birthday, a glorious function. We will participate in this function not as witnesses, not as visitors but as HIS messengers of love and service, as His dear sevadals. We will render security and utility services in Prashanthi Nilayam from 15th to 30th Nov'2018 in two batches ALONG WITH Andhra Pradesh.

This is the first opportunity to be given to the state of Telangana. This is an opportunity given to each one of us to transform our lives from mundane to being purposeful. Through our seva, the devotees visiting Nilayam will learn the lasting impact that love can leave on each heart. Through our dedication, let us show that devotion is far beyond emotion and it is expressed in action. Through our discipline, let us teach silently that restraint can confer far more strength than waywardness. Through this opportunity let us raise ourselves to be HIS messengers of love.

It is now up to each one of us, especially Dist/Executive Presidents to utilize this opportunity through nominating befitting candidates who are young, energetic, devoted and experienced.



TRAINING & BRIEFING:

Kindly conduct adequate training camps regarding Prasanthi Nilayam Seva and equip all the sevadal, office bearers of District, Samithi and Bhajan Mandalis. This will improve the quality of service rendered. Adopt a special focus on first time comers to Prasanthi Nilayam. The nominated Batch In-Charge and Group Leaders shall also attend the Training/Briefing camps in the District.

MOBILISATION:

1. The DPs and EPs are requested to tour their Districts along with Dist.Service coordinator and Dist. Youth coordinator to mobilize the required Sevadal as per the allotment and criteria.
2. Contact all the sevadal as per the register, all those who did seva earlier and all drop outs. Contact them in person and motivate them to attend PN Seva
3. Allocate each area to one of the Dist. Coordinators so as to coordinate the process of motivation and mobilization of sevadal alongwith Samithi Convenors.
4. Contact all the active members:
 - a. Those who attended training camps in the Districts
 - b. The beneficiaries of SSSO activities
 - c. Medical follow up cases
 - d. Active workers of SSSVIP Villages
 - e. Participants in Vidya Jyothi
5. Focus on mobilizing youth, all those who participated in APRIL Youth Conference.
6. The District Youth Coordinators are requested to coordinate mobilization of youth and inform the District wise youth availability so as to deploy them in sectors appropriately. The DYCs and State Coordinators shall ensure that the youth are motivated, trained and briefed before attending PN Seva.

GUIDELINES:

1. All sevadal must be above 18 years of age. School students below 18 years shall not be deputed. If at all deputed, they will be sent back.
2. DPs/EPs shall depute Graduate/Post Graduate youth within the age group of 20 to 34 years with a height of 5'7" to 5'9", and well built with proportionate belly and shoulder and of normal to fair complexion for Core Group Selection.
3. All District/Samithi office bearers and sevadal MUST attend PN Seva compulsorily at least once a year as guided by our Beloved Bhagawan. The DPs, EPs are also requested to perform PN Seva and be a Role Model for sevadal of their Districts.
4. Dist. Presidents are requested to inform the nominated Batch in-charges, Group Leaders and sevadal to report to their duties on the allotted dates and time, perform seva for full period and leave Prasanthi Nilayam only after completion of the duty period. They shall not be sent for 2 or 3 days. The nominated Batch in-charges shall be able to know each sevadal coming from their District. Similarly, the nominated Group Leaders shall have knowledge of the sector proposed for them and must have rendered seva in that sector earlier.
5. Kindly note that Sevadal who are not fit or suitable will be sent back, as quality of Seva is utmost important. Sevadal who are negligent and persons suffering from chronic BP, Diabetes, heart ailments, old aged, physically disabled, mentally unsound and persons suffering from convulsions (fits) shall not be deputed for PN Seva.
6. Sevadal should bring their Identity Cards and scarfs. Identity Cards for sevadal shall not be issued at Prasanthi Nilayam. They must be issued only at the Districts.
7. **All gent sevadal must wear white dress during Prasanthi Nilayam Seva. They must have at least two pairs of white dress.**
8. **Car/Jeep/Ambulance/van drivers and Tractor drivers shall be sent with their original licenses. DPs are requested to identify particularly tractor drivers in their districts and send them as it is SWAMY's Birth day period.**

Note: Special batch reporting date is changed from 21st November to 18th November because free meals are served to all the devotees from 18th November to 23rd November and special batch will be assigned various works at the food court. The ladies and Gents reporting as a special batch should not be less than the number allotted.

3. Both the VICE PRESIDENTS and State Coordinators are requested to be in contact with DPs, EPs, DSCs and DYCs so as to ensure that the district wise allocation of sevadal is met for both batches of November 2018.
4. The State Mahila Coordinator Smt. K. Sudha will look after the works pertaining Mahila wing.
